

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
OPERATIONS CHIEF LINE LEADER**


The Chief Line Leader position will be utilized across service center boundaries as defined below for restoration support, training, and support during the performance of the crew's daily work. The Company and Union agree to allowing the Chief Line Leaders to cross service center boundaries.

The Chief Line Leader will be selected according to the Memorandum of Understanding 4.1 Company - Foreman Relationship Power Systems and Nuclear.

The positions and areas affected are as follows:


- Central Florida (POO) afternoon position can work in the Flagler, Port Orange, and Sanford service centers boundaries.
- Treasure Coast (SRO) day position can work Indian River, Walton, Okeechobee, and Stuart service centers boundaries.
- Central Broward (WGO) afternoon position can work in the Pompano, Wingate, and Gulfstream service centers boundaries.
- Manasota (WFO) day position can work in the Clark, Venice and Whitfield service centers boundaries.
- Central Dade (CEO) day position can work in the North Dade, West Dade, Central Dade, and South Dade service centers boundaries.
- Brevard (MLO) day position can work in the Titusville, Merritt Island, and Melbourne service centers boundaries.
- West Palm (RPO) day position can work in the Jupiter, West Palm, and Royal Palm service center boundaries.

The Chief Line Leader position will operate under the Chief Line Leader job criteria and as outlined in paragraph 4.1 of the Memorandum of Agreement. This agreement will become part of the MOA in the next negotiations.
