Florida Alliance for Retired Americans Resolves to Oppose the Florida Constitution Amendment to De-Regulate Electric Utilities

FLARA President Bill Sauers announced today "That among other actions taken a t the annual convention of Florida Allian ce for Retired Americans held on June 5, 2019, a resolution was unanimously adopted to oppose and defeat the Florida constitutional amendment ballot initiative know as **Energy Choice.**"

RESOLUTION TO OPPOSE "ENERGY CHOICE"

Whereas: Independent studies show there is little evidence that "Energy Choice" has yielded any significant consumer benef its in other states, and has increased consumer fraud and deceptive marketing while decreasing reliability; and

Whereas: Customers in states that have experimented with de -regulation have experienced decreased reliability with power blackouts and extended periods without power service, including potential brownout s; and

Whereas: Unregulated energy companies can cherry pick which customer to serve and require large deposits or deny service based on a customer's credit; and

Whereas: Research has shown increasing financial burden on, specifically targeted, low income, A frican American and senior communities in unregulated electric markets; and

Whereas: In 2018, residential cu stomers in deregulated "Energy Choice" states paid more for electricity than the average Florida residential customer.

Therefore: Be it resolved, that the **Florida Alliance for Retired American** shall oppose and work to defeat the adoption of the "**Energy Choice**" amendment to the Florida Constitution by proactively educating its members and Florida con sumers as to the dangers of the amendment and its misleading and deceptive language.
